IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- PLAN AHEAD. The Embassy has no photocopier/printer/stamps onsite, so prepare your documents ahead.
- ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS. The consular officer reserves the right to require additional documents to prove identity and/or citizenship, and ensure accurate and complete personal data entries.
- VALIDITY. Minor's passports are valid for five (5) years.
- NEED PSA DOCUMENT? Order online at psaserbilis.com.ph to have it delivered to your address abroad.
- NO NEED TO BRING PHOTOS. Your child's passport photo will be taken during your appointment.
- **PASSPORT NAME.** The name on your child's passport will follow the name on your PSA documents. We cannot use non-PSA documents as a basis for name change.
- TRACK YOUR PASSPORT. Keep a copy of your tracking label to track your child's passport six weeks after your appointment. You may also track your passport here: philippineembassy-dc.org/phpassport-finder/
